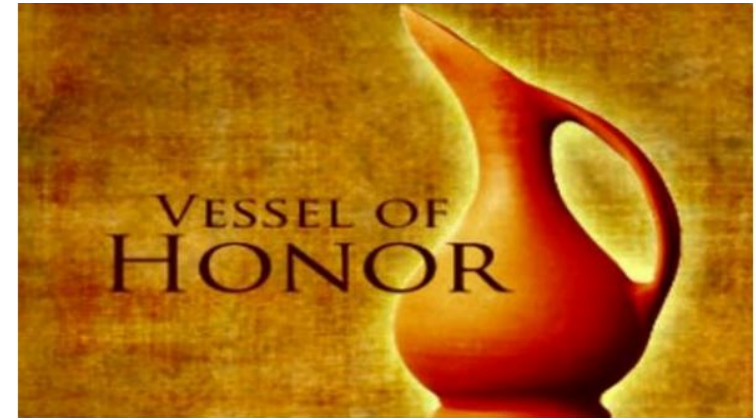

A Word in the Stone House

WHAT ARE THOU IN THE HOUSE 2 King 4 : 1 - 7

Life has little to do with speed;
but much with direction. And there
can be no direction without divine
instruction. Prov.13:1. Man's
understanding about life and his
environment is limited to his natural
senses. This limitation however, can
be overcome by the interplay of his
spirit and soul. Often times we fail to
acknowledge that man is a spirit
being, having a soul and lives in a
body. All of these three compartments
must be fully functional before
anyone can attain fulfillment; hence
the need to be spiritually alive (born
again). Proverbs 20:27; John 3:3.
